## Single Award Task Order Contract (SATOC)

### KEMRON-CMC Remediation Services, LLC (A Joint Venture)

Under this multi-year SATOC, KEMRON-CMC Remediation Services, Inc. (a joint venture with KEMRON Environmental Services, Inc. and CMC, Inc.) has been awarded an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) SATOC in support of the EPA Superfund sites located within the South Atlantic Division (Alabama, Mississippi, Tennessee and Florida). However, the Government reserves the right to utilize this contract for work associated with EPA Superfund sites and remediation projects located elsewhere.

Work will vary from site to site and will require extensive knowledge of remediation and cleanup of contaminated soil, groundwater, and buildings and asbestos, lead paint, and other toxic material survey, testing, abatement, and removal. Work may involve, but is not limited to:

- Extensive excavation and transportation of contaminated soils (to limit dust generation and avoid potential contamination of surround areas)
- Demolition of structures
- Soil-bentonite (s-b) slurry trenching
- Jet grouting barrier wall construction
- Solidification/stabilization (S/S) of contaminated materials
- Construction of RCRA type cap systems and monitoring wells
- In situ chemical oxidation (ISCO) and in situ enhanced bioremediation (ISEB) remedial injection services
- Operation of groundwater recovery and treatment system(s) to recirculate flow across the cell and supply feed water\
- Other incidental services may include: environmental consulting and/or engineering services

#### Awarded Task Orders

The first project awarded under this contract is a \$16.1 million task order for remediation services at the Picayune Superfund Site in Picayune, Mississippi. Under this TO, KEMRON-CMC will be performing the excavation of contaminated soils, construction of two barrier wall disposal cells, placement of contaminated materials in disposal cell, construction of a RCRA type cap system, and installation of a monitoring system and other incidental related work.
